



## Medicare ABN

Medicare will only pay for services that are determined to be “reasonable and necessary” under section 1862 (a) (1) of the Medicare law. If Medicare determines that a particular service, although it would otherwise be covered, is “not reasonable and necessary” under Medicare program standards, Medicare will deny payment for that service. Medicare may deny payment for:

- \***Comprehensive eye health exam:** 92004, 92014
- \***Office calls:** 99201, 99202, 99203, 99204, 99211, 99212, 99213, 99214
- \***Refraction:** 92015
- \***Visual fields:** 92081, 92082, 92083

For the following reason:

- \*Medicare may deny preventative or diagnostic procedures
- \*Medicare may apply part or full charges to deductible
- \*Medicare may deny frequency of procedure
